They would like to say a big thank you for all of your donations of cakes – they managed to raise

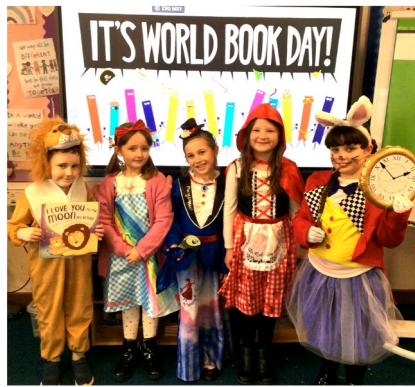

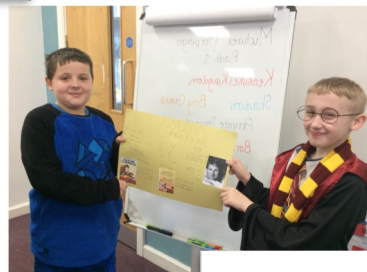
